All dogs had good temperaments and good mouths. On the negative side a few had high tail carriage.

Class 1. Minor Puppy Dog (10)

- 1. Bond's Cassom Fast and Furious at Olibond. 8 months blue dog, lovely head with square muzzle and dark eyes good forechest and reach of neck into well laid shoulders. Short and cobby with nice angulation, tight feet, keeping topline on the move and covering the ground with drive. Will watch his progress with interest. BPIS
- 2. Thomas' Abercrombie of La Vie Magnifique for Claramand. 8 months light blue of larger frame than 1 but a nice honest puppy with good topline and moved well.
- 3. Mitchell's Glowhill Cotton Eyed Joe

Class 2. Minor Puppy Bitch (12)

- 1. Warrington's Zakova Ally Kat. Beautifully presented black 6 months bitch, a real baby but certainly had her act together. Lovely head with melting expression and tight eyes. Good forechest and deep bodied, well ribbed with good topline and tailset. RBPIS
- 2. Darby's Lujesa Magic Touch of Classicway 8 months black. Nice expression dark eyes, good neck and shoulders just preferred topline and squarer shape of 1 nevertheless a quality young lady.
- 3. Kettle's Lujesa Rainbow's End.

Class 3. Puppy Any Colour (6)

- 1. Whiting's Annilann Miss Sing. Almost 10 months blue bitch feminine head, good neck and shoulders with excellent spring of rib, deep body and good bone moved with drive.
 - Strongly contested for top honours in puppy challenge.
- 2. Hackett's Lindridge Blue Delft 9 months light blue bitch larger built than 1 but a nice shape. In good coat, short hocks and a very close decision.

- 1. Thomas' Claramand Tantatious 10 months black and tan bitch, dark eye, well balanced head, level topline which she kept on the move, good tailset and width of thigh show in lovely condition.

- 2. Warrington's Zakova Mr. Moonshine, blue 11 months dog slightly longer than 1, well ribbed body with good angulation and in good coat moved with drive.

Class 6. Special Open Solid (3)

- 1. Black's Tojamatt Lady Cecil at Cleolivia. Black bitch with pleasing, balanced head, dark eyes and good bone, well presented.
- 2. Pretty's Kerriglow Fable With Joaldy. Black, sturdy dog with nice expression, deep chest and neat feet, short hocks.
- 3. Gostellow's Domeva Delphi

Class 7. Special Open Particolour (3)

- 1. Ray's Jardinisle Happy Times. Blue dog of solid build with well sprung ribs, correct tailset and in good coat, a handful on the move but happy and sound.
- 2. Mitchell's Glowhill Miss Saigon. Blue bitch, lovely head and reach of neck, well angulated. An honest Cocker not wearing her best coat today but moved well.
- 3. Wheatley's Wilmerella Keep Dancing with Melandroy

Class 8. Veteran (9)

What a lovely line up of veterans all a credit to their owners.

- Lockwood's Lujesa Casellina at Chimewood. Black bitch 7 and a half years, feminine head with dark eyes, clean throat and good reach of neck into well laid shoulder, square outline. BV
- 2. West's Sheigra Swing On A Star 7 years black and tan bitch, such a close call to 1, many of the same attributes, beautifully presented.
- 3. Gilmour's Show Champion Chavez Royal Liaison JW

Class 9. Junior Any Colour (4)

- 1. Chater's Izznbarr Izza Legacy. Black bitch, dark eye and pleasing head, deep chest with good spring of rib, merry on the move.
- 2. Moutrey's Sunzo Sonatina. Black bitch, nice head and body, well turned out, moved well.
- 3. Matthew's Sonham Sapphire Blue

Class 10. Maiden Any Colour (1)

1. Kavanagh-Bromley's Cachel Justbecause. Bitch on her own but has a sweet expression, adequate neck and good shoulder and angulation.

Class 11. Novice (2)

- Nicholas & Carter's Manacas Paper Doll. Black and white ticked bitch, up to size and well off for bone, drove purposefully around the ring covering the ground well.
- 2. Cocoran's Troverothway Hampton Rose. Black bitch with pleasing head and body did not have the movement of 1.

Class 12. Graduate (9) Such a strong class

- 1. Kettle's Lujesa Obrigada. Beautiful black bitch so well put together and a joy to go over, didn't put a foot wrong. Sweetest of heads, tight eye, square muzzle, clean throat, correct forechest, ample neck into well laid shoulders, deep chest and good spring of rib and good width of thigh. RBIS
- 2. Mathew's Sonham Blue Diamond Blue. Stylish dog well built with a good head and dark eye balanced all through and moved so well. Unlucky to meet 1 in this class.
- 3. Pitt's Olibond Let me be the one.

Class 13. Post Graduate Any Colour (7)

- 1. West's Sheigra Stargazer J.W. What a lovely red dog, full of presence and style, masculine without being over done. Lovely layback of shoulder and good forechest presented in excellent coat and condition.
